What a blessing it was to hear the thanks from the people of the villages because they had seen what it means to be loved by God's family. What a joy to see ten people stand before their village to publicly profess faith in Jesus during an evening service. What a privilege to watch God at work as he provided two donated pieces of prime real estate in two separate villages so that church buildings could be built. What an honor to see a group of believers become a little more like Jesus as they served in His name.
