

**The Mission Book is currently being updated. Below is an abbreviated list of items of interest. Should you have additional questions, please feel free to contact Mike Keeling at 303-325-5253 for additional info.**

- **TRIP COST:** Currently \$1850 US per person ( \$40,000 per 22 member team that includes medical pack and construction/well cost.)
- **PASSPORT:** You will need a valid passport with an expiration date of at least 6 months after your return to the US, according to the Brazilian Consulate. No exception. The Brazilian consulate website is very helpful.
- **VISA:** You will need a valid Brazilian tourist visa. New visas must be activated within 90 days of issue. It is strongly suggested that a visa service be used, such as Travisa.
- **Immunizations:** Although the CDC recommends many immunizations, you **MUST** have Yellow Fever as a minimum for gaining entry to Brazil. You must have your yellow immunization record to present to Brazilian Customs. Check with your physician for other recommendations. You will also need an anti-malarial.
- **Forms** are available for printing on the “forms” tab in the website. The travel waiver must be signed and notarized, and sent to the AMOR home office prior to leaving on the trip.
- **Packing:** You **CAN** get three days of clothes and personal items in two 12-lb carry-ons. This is what is currently allowed by TAM airlines for international flight from Miami. Reserve the checked bags for VBS, boat supplies, etc. As the baggage rules are currently changing frequently, make sure that you double-check your airlines for restrictions.
